TERMS & CONDITIONS

For Participating Schools

To be eligible to participate in the Act-Belong-Commit Connect Program *Under the Same Sky*, devised and produced by Co:3 Australia, students/teachers;

1. Can be located anywhere in the world.
2. Who are located in Western Australia –
 - a. Agree to liaise with Co:3's Youth & Engagement Associate to organise a suitable collection/ delivery method (at no cost to the school) for your black birds to reach Co:3 to be a part of a flock of 1001 birds, created by our WA community. This will be an integral component of the set concept envisioned by Naoko Yoshimoto for ARCHIVES OF HUMANITY, a new dance production by Raewyn Hill to be presented in the State Theatre Centre of WA in 2021.
 - b. Agree to be acknowledged by name (school) as a creator of black birds on our Company website and that no royalty, fee or other compensation shall be made payable to your school by your submission and usage as outlined below.
 - c. The final constructed birds will be used in the set at Co:3's discretion.
3. Must commit to provide/ source their own materials at their own expense for the creation of a black bird, as per the instructions and resources provided by Co:3, unless alternative arrangements have been made with Co:3's Youth and Engagement Associate.
4. Agree to Register students' Birds and Storytelling responses as the final step and provide some basic information about your school and location. This will be geographically mapped to demonstrate the reach of the project. Students have the option for their storytelling responses to remain anonymous if preferred.
5. Accept that any photos, written and drawn responses shared, may be used by the Company for the duration of the project, in the following ways -
 - a. for archival and reporting purposes
 - b. as part of a state-wide/ national and/ or global community showcase
 - c. for use in print and online publications
 - d. on the Company website and social media platforms
6. Agree to provide basic school statistical data (i.e. number and demographic of participating students) to assist Co:3 for reporting purposes and, be willing to share feedback on your (teachers and students) experience. This will likely come in the form of a short survey.
7. Will be provided with regular updates on the program.
